Zehnder's ComfoAir 350 HRV with its counter flow heat-exchanger recovers over 90% of the room temperature. This results in a significant reduction in heating and cooling energy use, while also noticeably improving indoor comfort. With over 90% of apparent sensible effectiveness and a power consumption as low as .30 watts per cfm, efficient HVAC design will be dramatically impacted. This translates into bringing quietly and continuously tempered fresh air into an air-tight energy-efficient house for the energy consumption of a 30 watt low-energy light bulb. In addition to HVI certification, Zehnder America currently offers the only Passive House Institute certified Heat Recovery Ventilator solutions in the US Market. Passive House Institute from Darmstadt Germany is internationally recognized as a leader in energy-efficient standards for high performance homes.
